Virtual/Online Learning for Students in Grades 6-12 2021-2022 School Year

*Free online education offered for students in grades 6-12 (costs may not exceed foundation allowance for any individual student)

*Must be enrolled as a CPS student

**Enrollment subject to application process, including review of past achievement*

*Online enrollment through Michigan Virtual School

*Michigan certified teachers through MVS

*Meets Michigan Merit Curriculum requirements

*District issued Chromebook (if requested)

*Eligible to participate in extracurricular activities

*Eligible to enroll in Career & Technical Education courses

****Students may be forced to return to in-person learning with substandard effort or achievement, as determined by CPS administration.**

****There are no virtual offerings for students in grades K-5 through Clare Public Schools.**

**These classes are NOT taught/led by the staff of Clare Public Schools. They are provided through Clare by Michigan Virtual.

Virtual learning is a very independent learning method which requires initiative and motivation on the part of the student (and family).

Guidelines for program participation:

1. Semester long commitment
2. Must enroll in seven (7) courses to meet CPS requirements to be on-track for high school graduation (exceptions may be made for dual enrolled students)
3. Must take all District assessments in person (NWEA, M-STEP, PSAT/SAT)
4. Athletes - weekly eligibility grade checks per our athletic policy
