- REQUIRED Courses:
 - English 10
 - Economics and Government
 - Biology
 - Math
 - World Language (Spanish I or American Sign Language I)
- Remember that you are working toward 2 things for your diploma:
 - 1. Meeting all graduation requirements
 - 2. Earning a minimum of 24 credits
- You must request any required classes you need to recover. These will take the place of an elective.
- Advanced Algebra II - Application is REQUIRED for course consideration.
- **Your blue course request sheet is due to Mrs. Murphy by Monday, March 18!! - make changes on your form with new date :-)**

What To Choose...?

You have 2 elective options...however...

If you earned an “E” in Algebra I, General Science, US History, or English 9, you will write that course in as one of your options so you can recover that credit.

Otherwise, you can choose 2 electives!

Options...

Dual Enrollment

- Offered at CHS, Online, or on MMC's campus in Harrison and Mt. Pleasant or any combination based on your schedule's availability.
 - **If this is your first dual enrollment class, you are required to take dual enrollment at CHS prior to attending MMC's campus or online.**
- You may elect to earn college credit only OR college and high school credit.
- We cover the cost of your college class as long as you earn above a C-.
- Any dual enrollment class will also appear on your MMC transcript.

Dual Enrollment Process

- MMC classes for the Fall are not set...yet!
- Purple application packets are available in the Counseling Office if you want to pick one up.
- Applying for a dual enrollment class takes 2 steps:
 - 1. Completing and turning in purple packet (date TBD)
 - 2. Completing the online MMC Dual Enrollment application (if this is your FIRST dual class).
- Once we return from spring break and finish testing, we can have you sign up to meet with Lindsay from MMC regarding your dual class(es). Sign up to reserve your meeting spot with Lindsay in the Counseling Office!

Things to Remember

- Your Blue Course Request Sheet is due to Mrs. Murphy by Monday, March 18!!!!
- When you work on filling out your blue course request sheet, be sure to complete it by requesting classes you want to take here at CHS.
 - Your requests drive what is offered!
- Once Dual Enrollment courses are determined, your schedule requests will then be adjusted.


