If you are on track to graduate, you have lots of options for filling your day!

- Dual Enrollment

- Co-Op (Applications are due THIS FRIDAY for NEXT YEAR!!)

- CTE (Applications are due THIS THURSDAY!!)

SENIOR YEAR SCHEDULE...HOW DO I FILL MY DAY??

Dual Enrollment

- Offered at CHS, Online, or on MMC's campus in Harrison and Mt. Pleasant or any combination based on your schedule's availability.
- You may elect to earn college credit only OR college and high school credit.
- We cover the cost of your college class as long as you earn above a C-.
- Any dual enrollment class will also appear on your MMC transcript.

SENIOR YEAR SCHEDULE...HOW DO I FILL MY DAY??

Co-Op

- Through Co-Op, you can work during your school day, and get paid!
- Your employment is based on your EDP and career goals
- Co-Op can be scheduled for 1, 2 or 3 hours of your day (either in the morning or the afternoon).
- Applications are due to Mr. Forsberg by THIS FRIDAY for placement for NEXT YEAR!

SENIOR YEAR SCHEDULE...HOW DO I FILL MY DAY??

CTE (Hours 1 - 3, we provide your transportation)

- If you are interested in CTE, now is the time to check it out!
- Program Offerings:
 - Advanced Manufacturing, Agricultural Science, Auto Technology, Construction Trades, Criminal Justice, Culinary Arts, Digital Media, Education Occupations, Health Occupations and Welding Technology
- All CTE Programs count as your senior year math credit.
- Dual enrollment credit is available in most programs and is facilitated by CTE.
- CTE Applications are due to Mrs. Murphy by THIS THURSDAY, MARCH 14!!!!

THINGS TO REMEMBER

Dual Enrollment

- MMC classes for the Fall are not set...yet!
- Purple application packets are available in the Counseling Office if you want to pick one up.
- Applying for a dual enrollment class takes 2 steps:
 - 1. Completing and turning in purple packet (date TBD)
 - 2. Completing the online MMC Dual Enrollment application (if this is your FIRST dual class).
- Once we return from spring break and finish testing, we will schedule a time for you to meet with Lindsay from MMC regarding your dual class(es).


MOST IMPORTANTLY

 - Your requests drive what is offered!
- Once CTE, Co-Op and/or Dual Enrollment are determined, your schedule requests will then be adjusted if those are of interest to you.
 - Be sure to turn in all required paperwork and applications by the due dates!
- Consider the green course request sheet your “back up plan” should CTE, Co-Op or Dual Enrollment not work out.
