Individual Building “Choice” Educational Program Showcase

Primary- Special Education co-taught classrooms in third and fourth grade. Students are getting the general education curriculum with special education support. Early Data collecting and analysis shows student growth to support this program.

Middle- Exit Ticket is a student response system being used to collect formative data on student achievement. Several of the core teachers at the Middle School are using the program. The real-time feedback to students has been valuable for reteaching.

High- Excel is a 30 minute period where students are with their grade level where they meet with their Excel teacher and upperclassmen help them to get caught up. This program is impacting the relationships, communications, and motivation. It is making student more aware of their progress and grade standings.

Pioneer- PLATO is the online curriculum being used to support students. Progress reports are sent home every four weeks and students are in charge of monitoring their progress in online classes.

District Collaborative Goals

The four collaborative goals have been condensed into three goals. We now have strategies and accountability measures built into the document. Each building has measurable objectives and strategies in their plan to support the collaborative goals. The goals will go on the agenda for Board of Education approval.

District Improvement Shift

With even more requirements coming from the State in School Improvement and District Improvement process an administrator, Amanda, will be taking over as chair. Jason will continue to be part of the District Improvement Team.

District Systems Review (Process Rubrics in the past)
