## **District Improvement Team Meeting Notes: 4/14/15**

### **Program Evaluation of Title I (MDE Evaluation Tool):**

**\*Primary School** – Summer jump start = We saw great student learning results from the summer program. We are adding Kindergarten prep class to the program for this year!

**\*Middle School** – Leveled Literacy Intervention (LLI) = It is working. We are seeing results. The evaluation is nearly done. We are looking to change the schedule. We are adding 8<sup>th</sup> grade next year to make the program 5-8<sup>th</sup>. We are also looking for math programs to have supports for math in the future. Alecks- Mgraw Hill and Khan are two for example. Middle School has submitted theirs.

**\*High School** – Tutoring and the Excel program = The tutoring program, according to data, is working about the same as last year. The staff has learned through the program evaluation process that it can offer support to students under an appropriate description that will ensure service to the full range of students in the “need” category. Excel is a program that the staff is very happy with thus far. Evaluations for staff and students will take place prior to the end of the year. The staff will evaluate the evaluation templates and make adjustments to improve the program accordingly.

**\*Pioneer** – Plato = Online curriculum program. This program is used to ensure that all courses are able to be offered at Pioneer. The Plato program has worked well this year. It has many excellent courses such as parenting and others that fill in the gaps where we are not able to provide certified staff. We are still looking into other online options, but Plato is our favorite at this time.

**\*District** – Technology = How do we use technology over-all as a district? How comfortable are the teachers in using technology? Readiness = 3, Knowledge and skills=3, Opportunity=4, and Implementation=3. Using our Collaborative Goals as a walkthrough checklist is our next step. We will keep looking at this for the district.

**Data and Student Achievement: Each Building will review goals, assessments and student progress. Gaps and areas of growth will be highlighted:**

**\*Primary School** = Maintenance phase of goals! Daily 5 for math, book study, SIR visit. Will be sharing about this at the board. Student engagement, culture and technology. Summer program.

**\*Middle School** = They have rewritten all of their goals at the recommendation of Sam. "Student will improve in proficiency in math," for example. All are also tied to the teacher evaluation rubric too. So we now have a direct tie from 5 D and SIP as well as our Collaborative Goals. The Middle School has been asked to share with Gladwin and Beaverton.

**\*High School** = Not changing the wording of the goals. Wording is related to the state average. They want to look at the Middle School plan as it connects to the 5 D.

**\*Pioneer** = Rewrote the entire plan. College and Career Ready goal (literacy, social studies), technology goals (writing and technology), problem solving (math and science), Organizational Goal= this year Mandy meets with each student on a regular basis to update on graduation progress.

**\*District** = We are in a maintenance phase of goals. We will be editing some language and changing some dates but otherwise the plan will not change much for the district.
