Meeting Notes from Tuesday, February 16, 2016

- **Superintendent's Update-** Superintendent Fillmore discussed looking critically at data. Student achievement should be the driving force before all School Improvement Plans. Moving forward this year, teams will be working to raise achievement scores in math and science specifically.
- **Career and College-Ready Implementation Status-** The team completed this diagnostic. The consensus was that while we feel that our readiness, knowledge, and skills for implementing career and college-readiness in ELA and Math are high we have gaps in the resources necessary to tightly align to our standards.
- **District Systems Review (Self-Assessment)-** The team completed this self assessment. There was discussion on implementation of data walls in each building. Additionally, the team discussed looking into Professional Learning Plans as well as way to upload state assessments results into Powerschool so that parents could have access.
- **Program Evaluations-** The Primary School is evaluating the summer school program, Middle School is evaluating their LLI reading interventions, High School is evaluating their tutoring program, Pioneer is evaluating the online credit recovery program, and the District will once again evaluate the use of technology. Chairs will have Program Evaluations completed by April 28th in time for Sam Ewing to review before submission.
- **School Improvement Plans-** All building are in a maintenance phase and are currently updating last year's goals and plans. The SIPs should be completed by the next District Improvement meeting of April 12th.
