Dear Parent(s):

Public schools are responsible for the total amount of tuition and fees for dual enrollment courses up to the statewide pupil-weighted average foundation allowance, adjusted for the proportion of the school year that the pupil attends the postsecondary institution. Based on this calculation, Clare Public Schools will currently pay up to \$557.21 per dual enrollment class. This money can be used toward tuition and mandatory fees. Tuition and mandatory fees exceeding \$557.21 per class, as well as all other fees and expenses are the responsibility of the parent and /or student. If the student receives a failing grade (C- or lower), is dismissed from the class or chooses to drop the class, the student/parents(s) are responsible for reimbursing Clare Public Schools for any amount paid.
